

Graduation Requirements

In order to graduate, all students are required to:

- 1) Meet the credit requirement and complete the core courses as reflected in the below chart;
- 2) Complete a senior thesis with a grade of C- or higher; and
- 3) Either of the following: Score at least 500 on the math section of the SAT, score at least 50 on the AFQT (Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery), or complete a math capstone.

In the following chart, one credit is equivalent to one year of study (or two semesters).

In addition to meeting the credit requirement, students must successfully	
complete Geometry (2 semesters) and Algebra II (2 semesters).	
Science	4
In addition to meeting the credit requirement, students must successfully	
complete Biology (2 semesters) and Chemistry (2 semesters).	
History	4.5
Core courses: Western Civilization I (2 semesters), Western Civilization II	
(2 semesters), American History to 1900 (2 semesters), Modern American	
History (1 semester). Modern European History (2 semesters),	
Government	.5
Core course: American Government (1 semester)	
Economics	.5
Core course: Economics (1 semester)	
Latin/Foreign Language	1 in Latin
Students must complete a full year of Latin. They must take two additional	3 yrs. total
years of a foreign language, whether in Latin or another language.	
Composition and Rhetoric	1
Core course: Composition (1 semester) and Rhetoric (1 semester).	
Depending upon the student's readiness for the standard course, a basic	
composition course may be required, followed by the standard course.	
Moral Philosophy	.5
Core course: Moral Philosophy (1 semester)	
Fine Arts	1
Physical Education/Health	1
Electives	3.5
